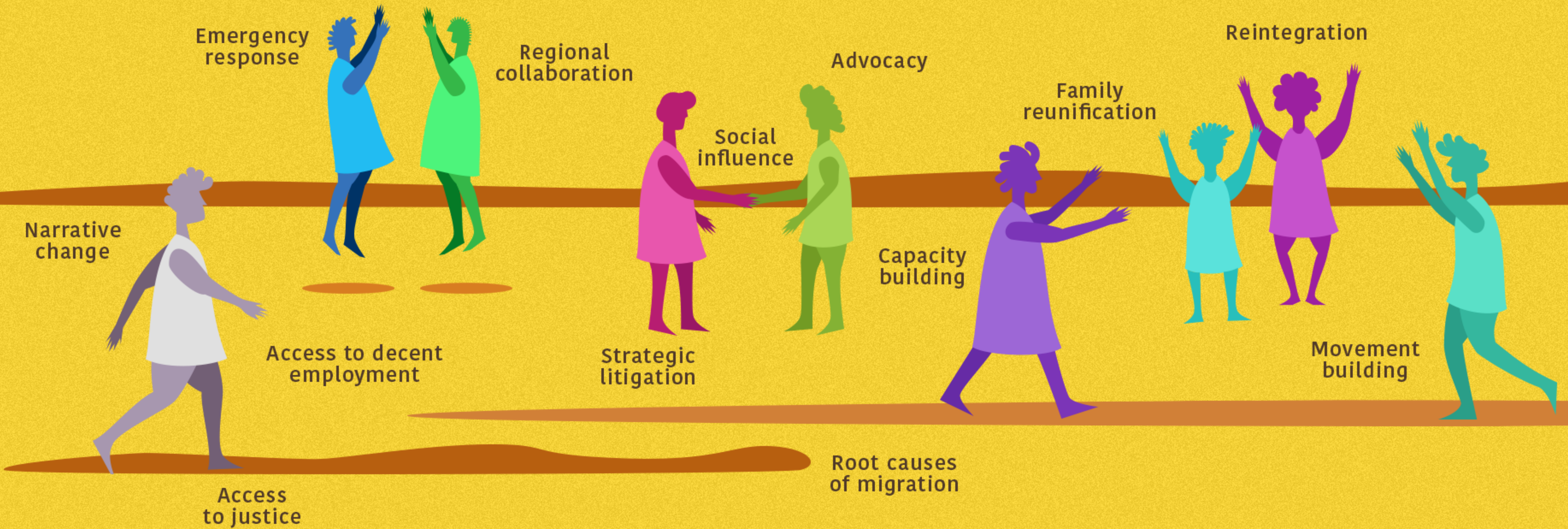

Our accomplishments

Movement building

- ▶ Ecosystem approach to support bringing together small grassroots organizations, direct and legal services, advocacy & impact litigation, communications and organizations focused on specific populations
- ▶ Importance of transnational convening coordination and support to gather grantees and different partners within the ecosystem.

Funding

- ▶ Facilitate multianual funding accompanied by capacity building & tech assistance support and that allows for agility to respond to emergencies while continuing drive for systems change, long-term impact
- ▶ Partner-driven funder strategy and partner-led advocacy

Grantmaking

- ▶ **Family Unity Fund:** Supported 2200 families; 1,558 Children and 281 parents; 2,136 legal cases and 600 educational/informative sessions
- ▶ **Emergency regranting strategy:** 2017 - to address Donald Trump's restrictive immigration policies; 2018 - Family separation and 'Migrant Caravan'; 2020 - COVID-19 and Rapid Response and Hurricanes Eta and Iota in Central America
- ▶ **Expanded strategy to address Venezuelan migration:** HIP's Venezuelans Moving Forward initiative launched in 2019 and has engaged dozens of funders, nonprofits, media outlets and other key strategic partners
- ▶ Operational and administrative flexibility in our grantmaking strategies
